How to receive an invitation to study on behalf of Kharkiv I.P. Kotlyarevsky National University of Arts

To receive an invitation to study, a foreign citizen must send scanned copies of documents to the e-mail address num.kharkiv@ukr.net <u>num.kharkiv@ukr.net</u> to the educational and scientific center of international education and cooperation:

completed written consent to the processing of personal data;

the first page of the passport, as well as a translation of the first page data of the passport into Ukrainian;

a document about previous education with grades (points) and information about the knowledge assessment system, according to which grades are given in the document (translated into Ukrainian);

a video recording (for performers of all specializations who did not study at Kharkiv I.P.Kotlyarevsky National University of Arts) performance of 2 or 3 diverse works, which demonstrates the performance capabilities of a foreigner who wishes to study at the university. The video recording must reflect a personal performance of the works.

After receiving the consent of the university for the arrival of a foreign citizen to Ukraine for the purpose of study, the university issues an invitation that is valid for 1 year.

For admission to Kharkiv I.P.Kotlyarevsky National University of Arts, it is necessary to provide a certificate from the preparatory faculty (from another university) on studying the language of instruction — Ukrainian.

What you need to know after receiving an invitation

After receiving an invitation, a foreign citizen must submit documents to the Consulate of Ukraine in the country where the foreigner lives in order to obtain a D-13 visa according to the list indicated on the Embassy's website. This list of documents must include the original "Invitation to Study". Prior education documents must be officially translated into Ukrainian and certified by the method, accepted in your country (legalized or certified with an Apostille stamp), before submission to the consulate. These documents must be officially recognized in Ukraine so that the university can issue you a diploma after graduation.

How to prepare for entrance exams

Entrance program requirements of Kharkiv I.P.Kotlyarevsky National University of Arts can be found on the university's website. Applicants can seek advice from teachers.

What documents must be submitted to the university

The following must be sent to the university:

a copy of the passport document, translated into Ukrainian and notarized;

a document (the original and its copy) about the previously obtained educational level, on the basis of which the admission is made (if available);

an appendix (the original and its copy) to the document on the previously obtained educational level, on the basis of which the admission is made (if available);

legalized documents on education;

health insurance policy, unless otherwise stipulated by international treaties of Ukraine;

8 photo cards by the size of 30×40 mm;

for admission to postgraduate studies it is necessary to provide a research proposal in the chosen scientific specialty or a list of published scientific works in Ukrainian or English, certified in accordance with the established procedure at the candidate's place of work/study.
